TLPGA Tour Practice Regulations

- A. The following exercises should be allowed:
 - (1) The players only;
 - (2) In designated practice areas only; and
 - (3) Within the specified time only.
- B. In each event, players have the responsibility to pay attention to the rules of practice.
- C. If possible, players should complete the registration before the start of the practice round. If your practice round begins before the start of the registration, such procedures should be carried out immediately after the practice round is completed.
- D. During practice days, players must be aware of their pace of play and the distance between the groups in front and behind. Players can play an extra ball in the following situations:
 - (1) Miss the fairway on his/her tee shot.
 - (2) Miss the green when approaching the green.
 - (3) No more than 3 chip shots on the edge of the green, and such play does not damage the course.
 - (4) Up to two shots can be made towards the green from a greenside bunker. Other bunker practice shots must be played away from the green (maximum 2 times).
- E. However, the above clauses do not apply in the following situations:
 - (1) If there is another group of players waiting behind, no additional practice shots are allowed.
 - (2) Once the latter group is ready to approach the green, the players on the green must leave quickly.

Encourage players to:

- Wear flat shoes during the practice period after the practice/ competition round; and
- Please pay attention to the damage to the course caused by the practice.

Disciplinary sanctions:

Highest fine - NT\$10,000



2023 Wistron Ladies Open Priority List

I. The following priority regards to a Member's playing status for Standard Tournament fields:

- 1. Members in the Top 60 on the Final 2022 Tour Official Point List, and have competed in 4 or more official tournaments in the 2022 season.
- 2. Winner of the Final 2022 Tour Official Money List (3 years exemption).
- 3. Only TLPGA Tour members who have won an Official Tournament (the year of win plus 1 year exemption. If multiple wins, 1 extra year to be added). This priority only granted to TLPGA Tour members.
 - Note: 2020-2022 winners are included (TLPGA Member must compete in 4 or more official tournaments)
- 4. 2023 QT (Qualifying Tournament: November 23~25, 2022) Top 20 players
- 5. Exemption: 23 players (Handicap must be 4 or under, if the exemption players are amateur players)
 (a) Up to 15 invitations by the 2023 Rolex Ranking before Top 400. (The ranking until August 31, 2023, shall prevail.)
 - (b) Up to 3 invitations by the sponsors and Up to 2 invitations by TLPGA.
 - (c) Up to 3 invitations by the host venue.
- 6. Final 2022 Tour Official Point Ranking Pos. 61~80.
- 7. Members finishing Pos. 21~50 at the 2023 QT (Qualifying Tournament: November 23~25, 2022)
- 8. A QT related to the certain tournaments.
- 9. Members finishing Pos. 81 and after on the Final 2022 Tour Official Point List.
- 10. Players finishing Pos. 51 and after at the 2023 QT (Qualifying Tournament: November 23~25, 2022)

Note: Categories 7-10 will be merged as one category and a re-rank may occur during the middle of season, with priority base on the order of the current year's Tour Point List. List will be updated accordingly.

- 11. Players who compete in any official tournaments in 2022 and never earned any points. Players who entered the tournament through qualifying rounds. (TLPGA Member must compete in 4 or more official tournaments)
- 12. Members of the 2022 TLPGA Tour.

Note: A Member must compete in any official tournaments in 2022, to be included in the final 2022 Tour Official Point List. TLPGA Member must compete in 4 or more official tournaments.

Exception: The number may be lowered for players whose total possible numbers of starts have been restricted to less than 4 solely due to her qualification status.

II. Exceptions based on type of Tournament:

- The priority list might not apply to co-sanctioning tournaments, co-organized tournaments, etc. In these cases, other Rules and Regulations will apply.
- 2. To be eligible for the priority entry status, one must be a member of Tour. If a player loses her membership, all exemptions are lost accordingly.

III. Tournament Field Size:

- 1. A Standard Tournament must have a minimum of 75 professional players in the field.
- 2. A co-sanction tournament must have a minimum of 30 entry allocated for TLPGA Tour members (with exception for co-sanctioning with US LPGA).
